Blended Training for Program Leaders



Benefits of Blended Training

- Increase training consistency
- Decrease cost of training to states and affiliates
- Better prepare our program leaders
- Ability to return to training materials right before leading a program

NAMI Family & Friends, a new 4-hour seminar, will be available for NAMI State Organization Affiliates to adopt beginning July 2018. The seminar informs and supports people who have a mental health condition. Participants learn about diagnoses, treatment, recovery, community crisis preparation and NAMI resources.

The seminar is not a replacement for other programs, like NAMI Family-to-Family, Homefront. NAMI Affiliates may consider offering NAMI Family & Friends every 4-6 months. Affiliates have the option of education and support while waiting for one of the multi-session classes.

Over 600 NAMI leaders from across the country contributed to the content, format and materials. NAMI Family & Friends was piloted in 2017 with 44 Affiliates in 7 western states. Support of 100 Women in Finance members and their commitment to offering the seminar.

Who will lead NAMI Family & Friends seminars? How will they be trained?

The seminar will be led by experienced teachers of NAMI Basics, NAMI Family-to-Family or NAMI Homefront. Seminar leaders will be certified by completing an online training.

How will the seminar be offered?

The seminar may be offered in-person or via video-conferencing. Video conferencing is the preferred method. The responsibility of the NAMI Affiliate and a representative of NAMI must be present. We do not recommend participants join the seminar from their home.

What is the NAMI Family & Friends eBook?

The eBook is a companion piece that provides more detailed information about the seminar. Paper copies are not available. The eBook is available as an electronic download. Paper copies are not available. The eBook is available in English, Arabic, Chinese, Farsi, Korean, Spanish and Vietnamese.

Are there any funds available to support the adoption of the program?

\$500 is available for each qualified NAMI Affiliate. \$250 will be released to lead the seminar and 2 seminar dates are input into the NAMI Portal. Once 2 online evaluations of the seminar are submitted via the NAMI Portal, the funds will be released. Each NAMI Affiliate may only apply for these funds once, which are available for 12 months.

How do we apply?

An online application will be available only to re-affiliated NAMI Affiliates. Re-affiliated should focus on completing that process. Contact your NAMI State Organization for details about re-affiliation.

What is the NAMI Portal?

The NAMI Portal is a web-based application that allows NAMI Affiliates to apply for funding and identify seminar dates.

Blended Training Process



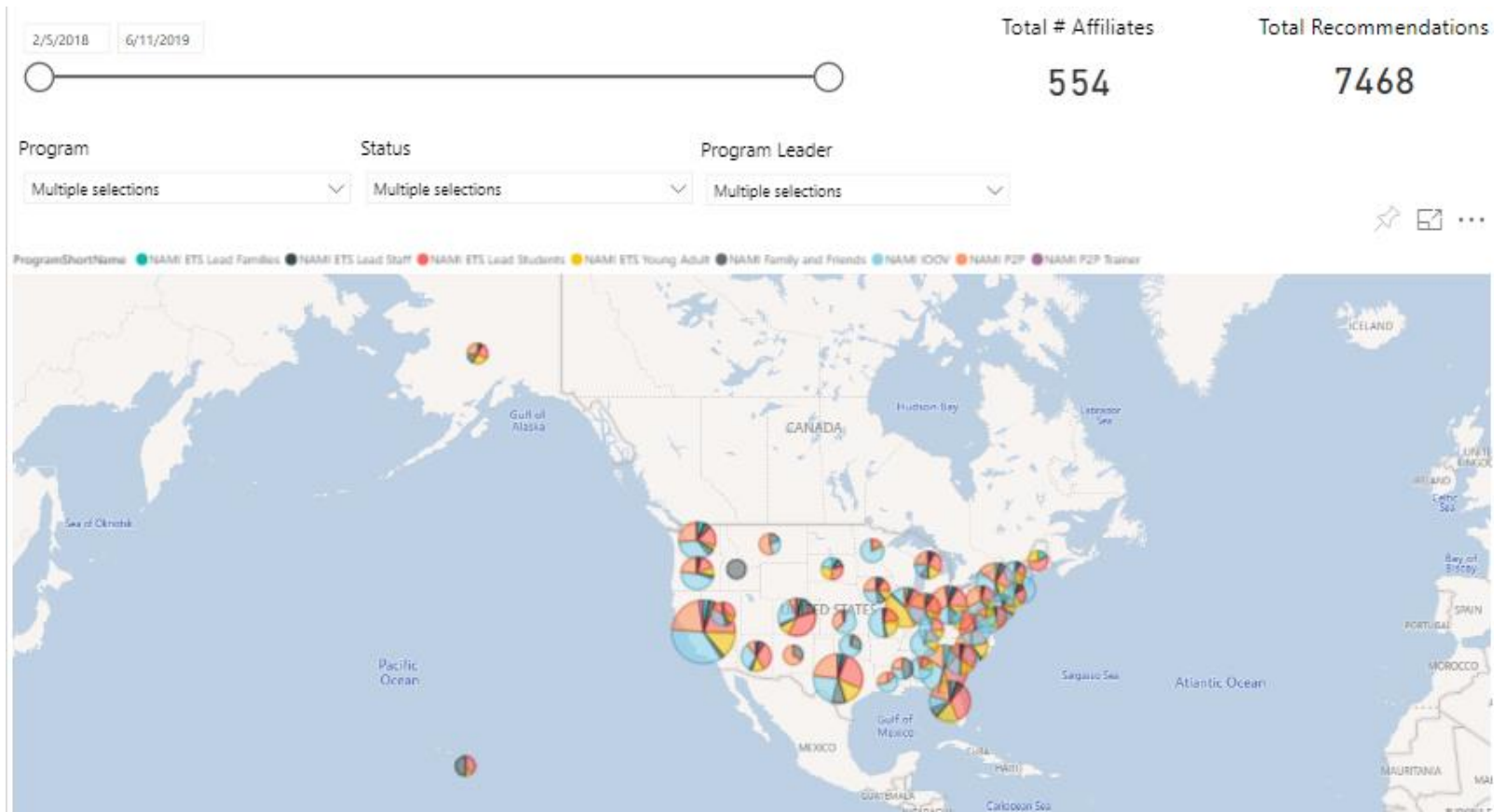
