# WHAT IS THE STUDY?

This study is for cisgender Women of Color who are interested in participating in an online focus group with other women from their shared racially/ethnically minoritized background. The goal of this study is to understand how early cultural messages about systemic racism influence Women of Color's engagement with traditional mental health services and inform their preferred method of coping with difficult life events. Focus group sessions will include 4-5 participants each and last for 90-120 minutes. Participants will receive a \$25 electronic gift card. Recruitment will run through November 30, 2023.

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Participants may be eligible for this study if they:

- Are 18 years of age or older
- Identify as a cisgender Woman of Color [Black/African American, Indigenous/American Indian/Alaska Native, Latinx, South Asian (e.g., Indian, etc.), East Asian (e.g., Chinese, Korean, Japanese, Taiwanese), Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, Middle Eastern/North African, Bi/Multiracial]

The researcher is seeking 25-30 participants for this study.
