## Be Proactive!

Try one-on-one interviews with a few other board members to narrow down the candidates before the club vote. It will allow you to get to know the candidates more as individuals.

5. Once you have elected a new club leader, hold a 'party' to introduce them to the members; this will make everyone feel more at ease with the transition.

6. Remember to document your successful meetings and events so the future leaders can get a strong sense of what works well.

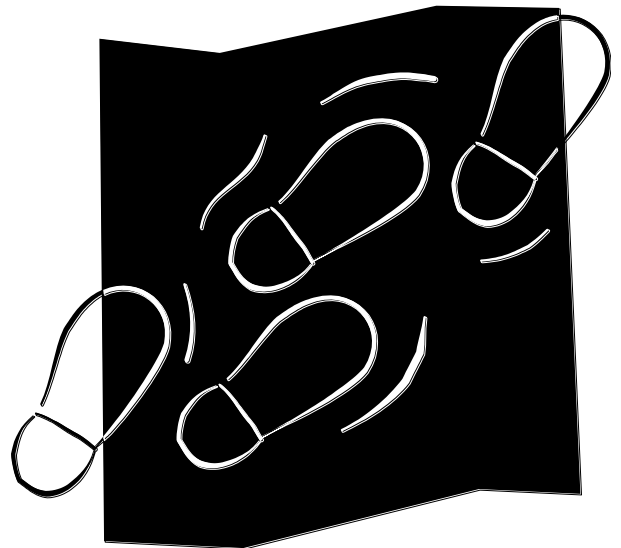
1. Build relationships with club members and consider whether they might have what it takes to lead the club.

3. Hold regular elections to prepare for the upcoming year; give yourself enough time to make the best possible decision.
